**17.30:** An evening meal will be served to those people who have **<u>pre booked</u>**, this will be served in the clubhouse / briefing room.

#### 19.00: An evening with our special guests.

Join Barry "Whizzo" Williams (Former BVRT driver & long standing professional racing driver), Barry Hawkins (Former Downton parts manager & 60's club racer) & "Jumpin" Jeff Williamson (Former British Rally Cross Champion) for an informal gathering including a Q&A session.

**20.30:** (approx): Close. Anyone camping is welcome to join Pete & Mark for a few beers around the Barbie (bring your own beer / drink).

23.00: All quiet on camp please.

#### **SUNDAY 4th May:**

All track day entrants will receive a full final instruction pack via e-mail from Javelin. In the event of any conflict between times given on here & on there, the Javelin information takes priority.

**8.30:** Can all arrivals, please follow the directions of the Marshals to park their cars & or trailers in the designated areas.

**Throughout the day:** There will be various attractions, not only a splendid selection of Minis & variants brought by you, but a traders area, a small car boot area.

We have a very special display of "Mini Variants" arranged by Jeroen Booij who will have advance copies of his new Book "Maximum Mini 2" available, North East MCR & "Miniworks" from Scotland will also have a club stand.

Light refreshments will be available throughout the day at the Track Canteen & the Blyton Park Karting Track will be open all day at very reasonable prices.

**9.00:** Drivers Briefing. All drivers and track passengers to attend this very important briefing. If you do not attend, you may not be able to get on track.

#### 9.30: The driving action starts.

To avoid too many problems between Very fast competition vehicles & drivers & those with less power or experience. Please note the following.

The track day is an open Pit event, this means that all drivers are free to enter & leave the track at any time, subject to appropriate direction of the marshals.

However. To reduce any potential problems that may be caused by large speed & experience differentials, the following **ADVISORY** plan is suggested.

**Each first half hour:** (30 mins from O'Clock to half past) The track is open to all cars, but priority is given to lower powered cars & less experienced crews. More experienced crews in faster cars are welcome, but they MUST take into account the slower, steadier nature of the session.

**Each second half hour:** (30 mins from half past to O'clock) The track is open to all cars, but priority is given to higher powered cars & more experienced crews. Less experienced crews & slower cars are welcome, but drivers must appreciate that they may be overtaken by very powerful vehicles travelling at anything up to racing speeds.

All drivers are reminded that this is a track day, **NOT A RACE**. At all times drivers must drive with consideration for those around them, must follow all instructions given by Marshals or other responsible people. If a driver is repeatedly warned by the marshals he may be asked to leave the track & may not be allowed back on.

**12.00:** Lunch break.

13.00: Prize giving outside office in paddock area.
