THE SUPER "SOUPED-UP" MINI :

LONDON : SPORTS CAR ENTHUSIASTS HAVE "SOUPED-UP" THEIR MINI-CARS BEFORE, BUT MR. PAUL EMERY OF LONDON, HAS GONE ONE BETTER AND PRODUCED THIS REALLY SOUPED-UP VERSION OF THE MINI, - WITH AN EXTRA ENGINE TUCKED INTO THE BOOT.

IT IS PICTURED HERE SHOWING BOTH FRONT AND REAR ENGINE AT THE FULHAM PALACE ROAD, LONDON, MOTOR-WORKS OF MR. EMERY. HE HAS BORED BOTH STANDARD MINI ENGINES UP TO 948 C.C.'S, WHICH, AT THE MOMENT, GIVES THE MINI A SPEED OF 100-M.P.H. GOING EVEN FURTHER UP THE SPEED SCALE, MR. EMERY WILL CARRY OUT FURTHER WORK ON THE CAR IN AN EFFORT TO PRODUCE A TOP SPEED OF 180-M.P.H. ON THE RACE-TRACKS. TOMORROW, AT THE GOODWOOD RACE TRACK LONDON GRAND PRIX DRIVER JOHN CAMPBELL-JONES WILL RACE THE CAR, ITS ENGINE SIZES AMOUNTING TO 2300-C.C.'S, AGAINST BIG JAGUARS AND THE 120-M.P.H. LOTUS CORTINAS.
